



This year's Community Impact Day was the most successful to date, mobilizing a record 2,320 volunteers across West Michigan. Volunteers supported 74 nonprofit organizations at 121 volunteer locations in Allegan, Fennville, Grand Haven, Grand Rapids, Hamilton, Holland, Hudsonville, Jenison, West Olive, and Zeeland. This year also marked the official statewide launch of Community Impact Day. Six additional Chambers across Michigan joined the effort on the same day, amplifying the collective impact throughout the state.
